Monthly Report & Outlook – September 2025

From the Chief Investment Officer's Desk

Market Overview

September month started on a positive note, following strong Q1 GDP growth data, announcement of GST rationalization, US Fed rate cut and optimism around India-US trade talks. Indian equities however erased most of their gains due to US government's decision to impose one-time fees of USD 1,00,000 on new H1B visa petitions and 100% tariff on branded drug imports.

All the above led to Nifty 50, Midcap and Small cap index delivering modest 0.8%, 1.4%, and 1.9% returns respectively, significantly underperforming global markets.

During the month, global equity markets continued their upward trend. The S&P 500 rose 3.5%, Nikkei 225 gained 4.6%, FTSE 100 and Hang Seng posted gains of 1.4% and 7.3%, respectively. Year-to-date (YTD), Germany's DAX leads with 35.7% gain, followed by Hang Seng with a 33.7% gain and Shanghai Composite at 20.9%. In contrast, BSE Sensex has declined -1.1% YTD, while MSCI India Index is worse at -1.7%, significantly underperforming the MSCI World Index (+16.2%) and MSCI EM Index (+25.2%). (Returns in USD)

Fixed Income

US10Y yields declined modestly to 4.15%, reflecting easing of monetary policy. In India, 10Y IGB yields remained flat around 6.58%, impacted by concerns around fiscal slippage and increased borrowings on the back of GST rationalization. Headline inflation rose modestly to 2.1%, supported by lower food inflation. During the month, Fitch Ratings revised India's GDP growth outlook for FY2026 upward to 6.9% from 6.5% earlier

Currency Markets

The US Dollar Index (DXY) traded in a tight range during the month, swinging between 96.5 and 98.6 before settling near previous month levels of 97.7, despite policy rate cut by US Fed and hawkish statement by US Fed Governor. Year-to-date, the dollar has weakened by nearly 10%, driven by policy uncertainty and global rate divergence.

The Indian Rupee (INR) depreciated against the dollar, ending August at 88.79/USD, its weakest level of the year. The INR has declined 3.6% YTD, impacted by trade tensions and fiscal concerns.

Among major currencies: EUR/USD remained resilient near 1.17, GBP/USD stalled around 1.34, USD/JPY hovered near 148, and USD/CNY was anchored between 7.10-7.15.

Precious Metals

Silver prices surged to \$46.65/oz, up 17% for the month and reaching the highest level since April 2011, driven by safe-

haven demand and strong industrial consumption from China's solar sector.

Monsoons ended with rainfall 8% above-normal, though distribution was uneven with northwest India receiving 27% more rainfall than normal while northeast India received 20% below normal with Bihar, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, and Meghalaya being major deficient states.

Flows & sectoral performance

DIIs remained net buyers (\sim ₹65,350 Cr), while FIIs sold off (\sim ₹35,300 Cr). **Top gainers**: Metals (+9%), Auto (+6%), Oil& Gas (+5%) **Top losers**: Consumer Durables (-5%), IT (-3%), FMCG (-2%)

Fund Performance

Over the 5-year period ending September 2025:

- Equity & Growth Funds: Annualized returns of 12-23%
- Balanced & Bond Funds: Annualized returns of 5–11% (Refer to annexures for detailed fund-wise performance.)

Fixed Income Outlook

Despite recent yield uptick, India's macro fundamentals remain resilient. Liquidity support and proactive policy measures are aiding growth. However, currency weakness, limited fiscal headroom, and geopolitical risks warrant a flexible, research-driven investment approach.

Equity Outlook

Valuations have moderated but remain above historical averages (Nifty at ~19x FY27e earnings). Near-term consolidation is expected until earnings catch up. Positive triggers include robust monsoon, GST reforms, easing inflation, and festive season demand. Focus remains on large caps, consumer durables, staples, and autos.
